### **Psychosocial support**

#### **Psychosocial Counselling to Adolescence**

We also extended psychosocial counseling and emotional support to our sponsor students to help them overcome any issues they may be facing.

Our psychosocial counsellor visited their homes, interacted with children to identify the root causes of the issues and facilitated them to overcome the issues with their inherent strengths where possible.

Our team provided specific one on one counselling to 5 children this quarter, family planning counselling to one of our recently married students, and counselling for academic improvement for four of our children who got poor marks in 1<sup>st</sup> term exam this quarter.

### **Psychosocial Counselling to Parents**

We also provided necessary counselling and guidance to families to ensure a child-friendly and peaceful environment for our sponsor children in their homes.

This quarter, we provided specific psychosocial counselling to 3 of our parents (mothers with alcohol issues) from our psychosocial expert.

All 16 youth have 1 peer each from within the group, who they specifically aim to provide support and counseling to under the guidance and support of our psychosocial expert.

#### **Social Audit**

We organized the annual social audit this quarter for the Sunrise Home, Reintegration and Host Community project in the presence of stakeholders, beneficiaries and parents. Income and expenditure details and progress made during the fiscal year under the project were shared and discussed.

Case Study Sarita Tamang



**Sarita** is a 12-year-old girl, studying in grade 4 in Kalikadevi Secondary School.

Before the implementation of this program in July 2023, she was studying in Kathmandu and living with her maternal uncle's family. She had been separated from her parents, as they were both facing challenges with alcoholism.

Later, we carried out a series of home visits and conducted a series of individual counselling sessions for both Sarita and her mother, and now her mother has reduced the consumption of alcohol. Sarita has returned to her home and started attending Kalika Secondary School. She now goes to school regularly and supports her parents in domestic work.
